

VISITOR INFORMATION NOTICE FOR THE TERRITORY OF AB LIETUVOS GELEŽINKELIAI GROUP COMPANIES

To ensure comprehensive safety, we provide the following safety guidelines for behavior on LG Group premises:

	Visitors are only permitted to enter the premises via the security checkpoint, having obtained a temporary written permit from¹ and in accordance with its requirements (time, location, conditions). Entry to the premises is prohibited for anyone suffering from infectious diseases. Minors must be accompanied and supervised.		It is prohibited to walk in production areas and along service routes without an accompanying company representative and without wearing a high-visibility vest. It is mandatory to wear other personal protective equipment as indicated on the signage for the premises/areas.
	Familiarize yourself with and follow the requirements for road signs and markings. Upon entering, familiarize yourself with the layout of the area where self-propelled vehicles operate. Comply with the Highway Code.		Pedestrians must use footpaths or pedestrian crossings; where these are not available, they must wear high-visibility clothing or a high-visibility vest.
	Cross railway tracks only at designated points. Before crossing a level crossing, stop and make sure that no train is approaching.		In traffic zones (at pedestrian crossings, within the railway danger zone), it is prohibited to use mobile phones, earphones, hoods or any other items that reduce hearing or visibility.
	It is prohibited to take photographs or film the following on the company's premises: - access control, CCTV, alarm systems or other technical security equipment at their installation points; - individuals whose personal data is sensitive (minors, those with obvious physical disabilities, those in a helpless state, etc.) without consent obtained in accordance with the procedure laid down by law; - for official or commercial purposes without the company's permission.		Vehicles are prohibited from stopping, parking, loading or unloading goods: - closer than 2.5 m from the outer edge of the outer rail of the railway track, - on footpaths, at pedestrian crossings and within 5 m of them; on the grass; - under raised gates or in doorways; - blocking or obstructing access routes to electrical switchboards, substations and fire-fighting equipment.
	The driver must reduce speed and sound the horn where doors or gates are open, as well as in other areas of restricted visibility. Before reversing, ensure that there are no people behind the vehicle and sound the horn.		Do not exceed the maximum permitted speed for vehicles in the area, which is indicated at the entrance. It is prohibited to carry passengers in goods vehicles that are not fitted with passenger seating.
	Park vehicles only in areas marked with signs. When leaving a vehicle, or when loading or unloading goods from it, ensure that the vehicle cannot move off by itself.		Any form of pollution is prohibited. In the event of a spill of lubricants or other hazardous chemical substances, notify the person in charge of the premises and take measures to collect them.
	Bringing alcoholic beverages, toxic and narcotic substances, or other illegal substances, or weapons onto the premises, as well as the consumption of alcohol and being on LTG Group premises whilst intoxicated, is prohibited.		It is prohibited to be within the working area of cargo handling and lifting equipment or self-propelled machinery.
	Smoking is prohibited, except in designated smoking areas marked with signs.		It is prohibited to ride bicycles or scooters across pedestrian crossings, level crossings or production lines.
	In the event of a traffic incident or accident on the premises, a company representative must be notified immediately. Those involved in the incident must not leave the scene of the traffic accident.		

¹ Depending on the layout of the area, the complexity of traffic, road markings and so on, the site owner may impose stricter requirements, e.g. require every visitor to wear a high-visibility vest whilst on the site, to enter the site only when accompanied by a company representative, to familiarise themselves with the company's traffic management rules, and so on.
